


WHAT WE'RE ABOUT


We are on a mission to connect people together in community, to the land through agriculture and to God through these experiences.

Weekday vs. Weekend

We're closed Mondays - unless it's a holiday, but if you're trying to avoid the crowds consider coming on a weekday. We have all the offerings except hayrides and make sure to get your maze tickets at the hilltop.

Weekend visits are a great time and you can enjoy hayrides from 10am-6pm. Best of all they are free.

Visit the Christmas tree field during apple picking season and beat everyone else to the best tree out there. October 7 & 8

Night Maze

Come enjoy the maze after dark in this family friendly (non-scary) event. Collect candy and treats at each station.

They are for sale


Farm Fact

Pumpkins & Squash

We have dozens of varieties of pumpkins, squash and gourds.

Grab a cart and head to the field to find the best pumpkins around.

Pumpkins are \$0.60/lb.

Mini-pumpkins are \$2.00

We have a large selection of winter squash to choose from for \$1.49/lb

Pay at the pond tent or hilltop.

Raspberries

Get a container from the info table and check availability. These limited tasty fall-bearing pick your own berries are located below the greenhouse.
\$6.50 per pint.

Corn Maze

Get tickets at any register or at entrance of maze on weekends.

Price \$13 for adults
Free for age 2 and under

After you finish, get your **free ice cream** at the "Maze Ticket Ice
Cream" window at the hilltop

Ice Cream

We serve Maine's own Gifford's as well as premium soft serve. Check out our farm specialty sundaes: the Peanut Butter Bliss and the Doughnut Split

Apple Picking

Grab an apple bag from the information tables. Apple varieties and locations can be found on the map on the other side.

Apples are \$1.89/lb except for Honeycrisp (\$2.99/lb) which are marked in the trellis orchards. Inquire at information table to find out what apples are ripe today. Pay at pond checkout or hilltop register.

Animals

Visit the goats and feed them grain from your hands. Please only feed them grain - we don't want them sick. See if you can get Mitchel the minidonkey to talk to you.


Doughnuts & Cider

Doughnuts are made fresh daily and our cider is a great treat - hot or cold. These are available at the cafe and we have boxed doughnuts at hilltop and pond registers.

Cider by the can, pint, quart, half gallon, and gallon as available.

Flowers

Pick a size bucket and fill with blooms. Pay at checkout where you can package and get flower food and care instructions. Med \$21.95 Lg \$27.95



STEP 3 GET HERE

When you arrive

If you come on a weekday, just pull right in off Union Street and park along the road on the hilltop. Everything you need is right there.

If you come on a fall weekend, drive past the farm (if coming from Bangor) and turn left onto Pember Road. The weekend entrance is about 500' down that road

Grab some apple bags and a pumpkin cart and head out to find some great produce and lasting memories.
